17	Plaintiff is a prisoner, proceeding without counsel, with a civil rights action pursuant to 42	
18	U.S.C. § 1983. The undersigned has separately issued an order screening plaintiff's complaint.	
19	The undersigned found that plaintiff stated potentially colorable claims for relief against	
20	defendants Jiminez and Tatarion, and ordered service of these defendants. The undersigned	
21	found that plaintiff's claims against defendant Himelblau were legally frivolous. For the reasons	
22	stated in that order, the undersigned herein recommends that defendant Himelblau be dismissed.	
23	Accordingly, IT IS HEREBY RECOMMENDED that defendant Himelblau be dismissed.	
24	These findings and recommendations are submitted to the United States District Judge	
25	assigned to the case, pursuant to the provisions of 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(l). Within fourteen days	
26	after being served with these findings and recommendations, plaintiff may file written objections	
27	with the court and serve a copy on all parties. Such a document should be captioned	
28	"Objections to Magistrate Judge's Findings and Recommendations." Plaintiff is advised that

1	failure to file objections within the specified time may waive the right to appeal the District	
2	Court's order. Martinez v. Ylst, 951 F.2d 1153 (9th Cir. 1991).
