ORDER

Petitioner is a state prisoner, proceeding through counsel, with a petition for writ of habeas corpus pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 2254. On August 8, 2016, this action was administratively stayed pending petitioner’s exhaustion of unexhausted claims. (ECF No. 21.) On November 3, 2017, petitioner filed a notice stating that all claims are now exhausted. (ECF No. 22.)

In accordance with the above, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:

1. The stay in this action is lifted;
2. Respondent is directed to file a response to petitioner’s habeas petition within sixty days from the date of this order. See Rule 4, 28 U.S.C. foll. § 2254. An answer shall be accompanied by all transcripts and other documents relevant to the issues presented in the petition. See Rule 5, 28 U.S.C. foll. § 2254;



4. If the response to the habeas petition is a motion, the motion shall be noticed pursuant to the Local Rules.
