ORDER APPOINTING COUNSEL

AND EXTENDING DEADLINES

Plaintiff is a state prisoner proceeding pro se with this civil rights action pursuant to 42 U.S.C. § 1983. On February 27, 2019, the court found that appointment of counsel for plaintiff is warranted. See ECF No. 27 at 16-9. Attorneys Jennifer Orthwein, Felicia M. Medina, and Kevin L.
