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1	3. Defendants' motion to dismiss the first amended complaint (ECF No. 35) is granted.	
2	4. Plaintiff's first amended complaint is dismissed with leave to amend, as provided	
3	in the magistrate judge's findings and recommendations.	
4	5. Plaintiff is granted thirty days from the date of this order to file a second amended	
5	complaint. Plaintiff is admonished that failure to timely file an amended complaint may result in	
6	this action being dismissed.
