On or about December 4, 2014, claimant Debbie Kay Cherms filed claims, in 23 the administrative forfeiture proceedings, with the Drug Enforcement Administration 24 with respect to the Approximately \$180,340.00 in U.S. Currency, Approximately 25 \$9,900.00 in U.S. Currency, and Approximately \$22,792.04 seized from El Dorado 26 Savings Bank Account Number 13058966 (collectively "defendant assets"), which were 27

seized on June 11, 2014.

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to forfeit required by 18 U.S.C. § 983(a)(1)(A) to all known interested parties. The time has expired for any person to file a claim to the defendant currency under 18 U.S.C. § 983(a)(2)(A)-(E), and no person other than the claimant has filed a claim to the defendant currency as required by law in the administrative forfeiture proceeding.

The Drug Enforcement Administration has sent the written notice of intent

- 3. Under 18 U.S.C. § 983(a)(3)(A), the United States is required to file a complaint for forfeiture against the defendant currency and/or to obtain an indictment alleging that the defendant currency is subject to forfeiture within ninety days after a claim has been filed in the administrative forfeiture proceedings, unless the court extends the deadline for good cause shown or by agreement of the parties. That deadline is March 4, 2015.
- 4. As provided in 18 U.S.C. § 983(a)(3)(A), the parties wish by agreement to extend to May 4, 2015, the time in which the United States is required to file a civil complaint for forfeiture against the defendant currency and/or to obtain an indictment alleging that the defendant currency is subject to forfeiture.

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1	5. Accordingly, the parties agree that the deadline by which the United States		
2	shall be required to file a complaint for forfeiture against the defendant currency and/or		
3	to obtain an indictment alleging that the defendant currency is subject to forfeiture shall		
4	be extended to May 4, 2015.
