18	It is hereby stipulated by and between the United States of America and claimant David P. Braut				
19	("claimant"), by and through their respective counsel, as follows:				
20	1. On or about December 18, 2014, claimant filed a claim in the administrative forfeiture				
21	proceeding with the Drug Enforcement Administration with respect to the Approximately \$305,120.00 in				
22	U.S. Currency (hereafter "defendant currency"), which was seized on or about July 7, 2014.				
23	2. The Drug Enforcement Administration has sent the written notice of intent to forfeit				
24	required by 18 U.S.C. § 983(a)(1)(A) to all known interested parties. The time has expired for any				
25	person to file a claim to the defendant currency under 18 U.S.C. § 983(a)(2)(A)-(E), and no person other				
26	than claimant has filed a claim to the defendant currency as required by law in the administrative				
27	forfeiture proceeding.

Under 18 U.S.C. § 983(a)(3)(A), the United States is required to file a complaint for
 forfeiture against the defendant currency and/or to obtain an indictment alleging that the defendant
 currency is subject to forfeiture within ninety days after a claim has been filed in the administrative
 forfeiture proceeding, unless the court extends the deadline for good cause shown or by agreement of the
 parties. That deadline was March 18, 2015.

6 4. By Stipulation and Order filed March 17, 2015, the parties stipulated to extend to May 18,
7 2015, the time in which the United States is required to file a civil complaint for forfeiture against the
8 defendant currency and/or to obtain an indictment alleging that the defendant currency is subject to
9 forfeiture.

5. By Stipulation and Order filed May 14, 2015, the parties stipulated to extend to July 17,
2015, the time in which the United States is required to file a civil complaint for forfeiture against the
defendant currency and/or to obtain an indictment alleging that the defendant currency is subject to
forfeiture.

6. By Stipulation and Order filed July 13, 2015, the parties stipulated to extend to October
15, 2015, the time in which the United States is required to file a civil complaint for forfeiture against the
defendant currency and/or to obtain an indictment alleging that the defendant currency is subject to
forfeiture.

7. By Stipulation and Order filed September 28, 2015, the parties stipulated to extend to
December 14, 2015, the time in which the United States is required to file a civil complaint for forfeiture
against the defendant currency and/or to obtain an indictment alleging that the defendant currency is
subject to forfeiture.

8. By Stipulation and Order filed December 15, 2015, the parties stipulated to extend to
February 12, 2016, the time in which the United States is required to file a civil complaint for forfeiture
against the defendant currency and/or to obtain an indictment alleging that the defendant currency is
subject to forfeiture.

9. By Stipulation and Order filed February 18, 2016, the parties stipulated to extend to April
12, 2016, the time in which the United States is required to file a civil complaint for forfeiture against the
defendant currency and/or to obtain an indictment alleging that the defendant currency is subject to

1 forfeiture.

10. As provided in 18 U.S.C. § 983(a)(3)(A), the parties wish by agreement to further extend
to June 10, 2016, the time in which the United States is required to file a civil complaint for forfeiture
against the defendant currency and/or to obtain an indictment alleging that the defendant currency is
subject to forfeiture.

6 11. Accordingly, the parties agree that the deadline by which the United States shall be
7 required to file a complaint for forfeiture against the defendant currency and/or to obtain an indictment
8 alleging that the defendant currency is subject to forfeiture shall be extended to June 10, 2016.
