A COMPLAINT FOR FORFEITURE AND/OR TO OBTAIN AN INDICTMENT 14 2014 PORSCHE PANAMERA S; VIN: ALLEGING FORFEITURE WP0AB2A75EL056429; LICENSE NUMBER: 15 7EYU646 16 Defendant. 17 It is hereby stipulated by and between the United States of America and claimant Johnny Luong 18 ("claimant"), by and through their respective counsel, as follows: 19 20 On or about January 23, 2015, claimant Johnny Luong filed a claim in the administrative forfeiture proceedings with the Drug Enforcement Administration with respect to the 2014 Porsche 21 22 Panamera S; VIN: WP0AB2A75EL056429; LICENSE NUMBER: 7EYU646 ("defendant vehicle"), which was seized on October 2, 2014. 23 2. The Drug Enforcement Administration has sent the written notice of intent to forfeit 24 required by 18 U.S.C. § 983(a)(1)(A) to all known interested parties. The time has expired for any 25 26 person to file a claim to the defendant currency under 18 U.S.C. § 983(a)(2)(A)-(E), and no person 27 other than the claimant has filed a claim to the defendant currency as required by law in the administrative forfeiture proceeding. 28

- 3. Under 18 U.S.C. § 983(a)(3)(A), the United States is required to file a complaint for forfeiture against the defendant currency and/or to obtain an indictment alleging that the defendant currency is subject to forfeiture within ninety days after a claim has been filed in the administrative forfeiture proceedings, unless the court extends the deadline for good cause shown or by agreement of the parties. That deadline is April 23, 2015.
- 4. As provided in 18 U.S.C. § 983(a)(3)(A), the parties wish by agreement to extend to June 22, 2015, the time in which the United States is required to file a civil complaint for forfeiture against the defendant currency and/or to obtain an indictment alleging that the defendant currency is subject to forfeiture.
- 5. Accordingly, the parties agree that the deadline by which the United States shall be required to file a complaint for forfeiture against the defendant currency and/or to obtain an indictment alleging that the defendant currency is subject to forfeiture shall be extended to June 22, 2015.
