41(a)(1)(A)(i). However, defendants may stipulate to dismissal pursuant to Rule 41(a)(1)(A)(ii).

Should defendants decline to stipulate, the court may dismiss this action based upon plaintiff's request, "on terms that the court considers proper." Fed. R. Civ. P. 41(a)(2). Accordingly, it is ORDERED that defendants shall have seven days to file and serve a stipulation to the dismissal of this action pursuant to Rule 41(a)(1)(A)(ii), or to otherwise respond to plaintiff's motion to dismiss.
