ORDER TRANSFERRING CASE TO THE

18 Plaintiff, a state prisoner proceeding pro se, has filed a civil rights action pursuant
19 to 42 U.S.C. § 1983, together with a request to proceed in forma pauperis pursuant to
20 28 U.S.C. § 1915.

21 In his complaint, plaintiff alleges violations of his civil rights by defendants. The
22 alleged violations took place in Sacramento County, which is part of the Sacramento
23 Division of the United States District Court for the Eastern District of California.
24 Therefore, the complaint should have been filed in the Sacramento Division.

25 Pursuant to Local Rule 120(f), a civil action which has not been commenced in
26 the proper court may, on the court's own motion, be transferred to the proper court.
27 Therefore, this action will be transferred to the Sacramento Division. This court will not
28 rule on plaintiff's request to proceed in forma pauperis.
