25	Local Rule 110 provides that failure to comply with the Local Rules "may be grounds for

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1	Finally, Rule 41(b) of the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure provides:	
2	Involuntary Dismissal; Effect. If the plaintiff fails to prosecute or	
3	to comply with these rules or a court order, a defendant may move to dismiss the action or any claim against it. Unless the dismissal	
4 5	order states otherwise, a dismissal under this subdivision (b) and any dismissal not under this ruleexcept one for lack of jurisdiction, improper venue, or failure to join a party under Rule 19operates as an adjudication on the merits.

7	Good cause appearing, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that, within thirty days from the date	
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10	of prosecution; and (b) action dismissed based on plaintiff's failure to comply with these rules	
11	and a court order. Such failure shall result in a recommendation that this action be dismissed
