The matter was referred to a United States Magistrate Judge pursuant to 19 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1)(B) and Local Rule 302. 20 On April 14, 2020, the magistrate judge filed findings and recommendations herein which 21 were served on all parties and which contained notice to all parties that any objections to the 22 findings and recommendations were to be filed within thirty days. Following multiple extensions 23 of time, plaintiff was granted sixty days from January 11, 2021, in which to file objections. That 24 time has passed, and neither party has filed objections to the findings and recommendations. 25 The court has reviewed the file and finds the findings and recommendations to be 26 supported by the record and by the magistrate judge's analysis. Accordingly, IT IS HEREBY 27 ORDERED that: 28 1. The findings and recommendations filed April 14, 2020, are adopted in full;

1	2. Defendant's motion for summary judgment (ECF No. 71) is granted; and
2	3. This action is terminated.
