	T IS HEREBY STIPULATED by and between

the parties through their undersigned counsel, subject to the approval of the Court, that DAVID JOHNSON be awarded attorney fees and expenses in the amount of \$7,200.00 under the Equal Access to Justice Act (EAJA), 28 U.S.C. § 2412(d). This amount represents compensation for all legal services rendered on behalf of Plaintiff by counsel in connection with this civil action, in accordance with 28 U.S.C. §§ 1920; 2412(d).

After the Court issues an order for EAJA fees to DAVID JOHNSON, the government will consider the matter of assignment of EAJA fees to PETER BRIXIE. The retainer agreement containing the assignment is attached as exhibit 1. Pursuant to *Astrue v. Ratliff*, 130 S.Ct. 2521, 2529 (2010), the ability to honor the assignment will depend on whether the fees are subject to any offset allowed under the United States Department of the Treasury's Offset Program. After the order for EAJA fees is entered, the government will determine whether they are subject to any offset.

Fees shall be made payable to DAVID JOHNSON, but if the Department of the Treasury determines that DAVID JOHNSON does not owe a federal debt, then the government shall cause the payment of fees, expenses and costs to be made directly to PETER BRIXIE pursuant to the

	This stipulation constitutes a compromise settlement of DAVID JOHNSON vs.

7	connection with this action. This award is without prejudice to the rights of PETER BRIXIE to
,	seek Social Security Act attorney fees under 42 U.S.C. § 406(b), subject to the savings clause
8	provisions of the EAJA.
