17	Plaintiff, a prisoner proceeding pro se, brings this civil rights action pursuant to 42		
18	U.S.C. § 1983. The matter was referred to a United States Magistrate Judge pursuant to Eastern		
19	District of California local rules.		
20	On July 20, 2018, the Magistrate Judge filed findings and recommendations herein		
21	which were served on the parties and which contained notice that the parties may file objections		
22	within a specified time. The Magistrate Judge has recommended dismissal of Charon and Angle

3	2. Plaintiff's motion for voluntary dismissal of defendant Charon and Angle		
4	(Doc. 71) is granted;		
5	3.	Defendants Charon and Angle are dismissed and this action shall proceed	
6	as against defendants	ts Custino and Snow; and	
7	4.	Plaintiff's motion for injunctive relief (Doc. 60) is denied.
