The thirty day period has now expired, and petitioner has not responded 20 to the court's order and has not filed the required document. 21 In addition to failing to comply with the court's October 6, 2016 order, petitioner has 22 refused multiple mailings from the court. The October 6, 2016 order was served on petitioner's 23 address of record and returned by the postal service with the notation that delivery had been 24 refused. The order was re-served on petitioner's address of record on October 26, 2016 and has 25 not been returned. Petitioner is informed that refusal of court orders does not obviate his 26 responsibility to prosecute this action and comply with court orders. 27 In accordance with the above, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the Clerk of the Court is 28 directed to assign a district judge to this case; and 1

IT IS HEREBY RECOMMENDED that this action be dismissed without prejudice. These findings and recommendations are submitted to the United States District Judge assigned to this case, pursuant to the provisions of 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1). Within twenty one days after being served with these findings and recommendations, petitioner may file written objections with the court. Such document should be captioned "Objections to Magistrate Judge's Findings and Recommendations." Local Rule 304(d). Petitioner is advised that failure to file objections within the specified time may waive the right to appeal the District Court's order. Martinez v. Ylst, 951 F.2d 1153 (9th Cir. 1991).
