It appears plaintiff is requesting appointment of counsel pursuant to 42 U.S.C. § 2000e-5(f)(1)(B). 18 19 Any successful application for appointment of counsel must comply with criteria set forth 20 in Bradshaw v. Zoological Society of San Diego, 662 F.2d 1301 (9th Cir. 1981). Before 21 appointing counsel to plaintiff, the court must consider (1) plaintiff's financial resources, (2) the 22 efforts already made by plaintiff to secure counsel, and (3) plaintiff's likelihood of success on the merits. Id. at 1318. Appointment of counsel is not a matter of right. See Ivey v. Board of 23 24 Regents, 673 F. 2d 266 (9th Cir. 1982). The court previously denied plaintiff's request for appointment of counsel. ECF No. 9. In 25 26 light of the findings and recommendations recommending dismissal of this action, plaintiff cannot 27 demonstrate the third factor required under Bradshaw. The court has therefore determined 28 appointment of counsel is not warranted in this matter.
