19	On April 15, 2016, plaintiff filed a notice of voluntary dismissal pursuant to Federal Rule	
20	of Civil Procedure 41(a)(1)(A)(i). (ECF No. 10.) Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 41(a)(1)(A)	
21	provides that "the plaintiff may dismiss an action without a court order by filing (i) a notice of	
22	dismissal before the opposing party serves either an answer or a motion for summary judgment	
23	" Fed. R. Civ. P. 41(a)(1)(A)(i); see also United States v. Real Property Located at 475 Martin	
24	<u>Lane, Beverly Hills, CA</u> , 545 F.3d 1134, 1145 (9th Cir. 2008) (noting that dismissal under Rule	
25	41(a)(1)(A)(i) requires no action on the part of the court and divests the court of jurisdiction once	
26	the notice of voluntary dismissal is filed).	
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Because defendant has not yet served an answer or motion for summary judgment in this case, plaintiff's request for dismissal is effective without a court order. Nevertheless, for purposes of clarity only, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:

- 1. This action is dismissed without prejudice pursuant to Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 41(a)(1)(A)(i).
- 2. All scheduled dates and deadlines are vacated.
- 3. The Clerk of Court shall close this case.
