Accordingly, the request to proceed in forma pauperis will be granted.1 20 21 The determination that plaintiff may proceed in forma pauperis does not complete the 22 required inquiry. Pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 1915(e)(2), the court is directed to dismiss the case at 23 any time if it determines the allegation of poverty is untrue, or the action is frivolous or malicious, 24 fails to state a claim on which relief may be granted, or seeks monetary relief against an immune 25 defendant. The court cannot make this determination on the present record. Therefore, the court 26 reserves decision on these issues until the record is sufficiently developed.
