26	the hearing, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:	
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1	1. Plaintiff's motion to compel compliance with the third party subpoena she served on	
2	Schmidt (ECF Nos. 19, 44) is GRANTED. Schmidt shall produce documents	
3	responsive to the requests set forth in plaintiff's subpoena within a reasonable	
4	timeframe agreed upon by counsel for plaintiff and Schmidt.	
5	2. Plaintiff's request to withdraw her motion to compel against V.A. Rodden, Inc. (ECF	
6	No. 51) is GRANTED.	
7	3. This order resolves the motions filed at ECF Nos. 19, 30, 44, 45, and 51.	
8	IT IS SO ORDERED.
