ORDER

Plaintiff did not timely file a motion for summary judgment. By order filed October 19, 2016, plaintiff was ordered to show cause why this action should not be dismissed for failure to prosecute. It is incumbent on plaintiff to file a motion for summary judgment which sets forth the errors in the record that she believes were committed by the Administrative Law Judge in reviewing her case. The scheduling order which was issued May 5, 2016 sets forth the format for the motion for summary judgment. Plaintiff will be granted an extension of time to file her motion.

Accordingly, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:

1. The order to show cause (ECF No. 18) is discharged.


