Plaintiff Lafonzo Turner is a state prisoner proceeding pro se and in forma pauperis with this civil rights action brought under 42 U.S.C. § 1983. The court has found that appointment of counsel for plaintiff is warranted. See ECF Nos. 43, 48. Alexander L. Nowinski has been selected from the Court’s Pro Bono Attorney Panel to represent plaintiff and has agreed to be appointed for the limited purpose of representing plaintiff through the resolution of any dispositive motions. The deadline for filing dispositive motions shall be Friday, May 31, 2019.

Accordingly, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:


1. Alexander L. Nowinski is appointed as limited purpose counsel for plaintiff in the above entitled matter. This appointment is for the limited purpose of representing plaintiff through dispositive motions.

5. The deadline for filing dispositive motions in this case shall be Friday, May 31, 2019.
6. The parties are encouraged to engage in informal settlement negotiations during this period and to ask Ms. Park to schedule a mediation conference if so indicated.
