18	2016, plaintiff's complaint was dismissed for failure to state a claim, and plaintiff was granted	
19	leave to file an amended complaint. (ECF No. 8.) Plaintiff's time to amend was extended three	
20	times, with a final deadline of February 14, 2017. (ECF No. 18.) That date has passed, and	
21	plaintiff has not filed an amended complaint.	
22	Accordingly, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that plaintiff's motion for third party service	
23	(ECF No. 16) is denied as moot.	
24	IT IS HEREBY RECOMMENDED that this action be dismissed without prejudice. See	
25	Local Rule 110; Fed. R. Civ. P. 41(b).	
26	These findings and recommendations are submitted to the United States District Judge	
27	assigned to the case, pursuant to the provisions of 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(l). Within fourteen days	
28	after being served with these findings and recommendations, plaintiff may file written objections	

with the court. The document should be captioned "Objections to Magistrate Judge's Findings and Recommendations." Plaintiff is advised that failure to file objections within the specified time may waive the right to appeal the District Court's order. Martinez v. Ylst, 951 F.2d 1153 (9th Cir. 1991).
