ORDER

18 On May 5, 2017, the court denied plaintiff's application to proceed in forma pauperis and
19 ordered plaintiff to pay the filing fee. (ECF No. 64.) On May 25, 2017, plaintiff filed a motion
20 for a ninety days extension of time to pay the filing fee. (ECF No. 68.) Plaintiff alleges that he
21 requires ninety days to "attempt to extract money from bank accounts." (Id.)

22 Plaintiff does not identify the bank accounts he will attempt to obtain money from.
23 Plaintiff also does not discuss why he requires ninety days to obtain this money. Accordingly,
24 plaintiff is granted a forty-five days extension to pay the filing fee. Any further requests for
25 extension of time must be supported by substantial cause.


26 Good cause appearing, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:
