26	Court finds the findings and recommendations to be supported by the record and by proper

3	2. Defendants' motion to require Plaintiff to post a security (ECF No. 28) is denied;	
4	3. Defendants shall file a response to the complaint within thirty days of the date this	
5	Order is filed.
