20 Pursuant to E.D. Cal. Local Rules 143 and 144, the parties submit this stipulation and
 21 proposed order to modify the Scheduling Order.

22 The Ninth Circuit transferred this matter to this Court for a de novo review of Petitioner's
 23 citizenship claim under 8 U.S.C. 1252(b)(5)(B). The Court entered a Scheduling Order with a
 24 discovery cutoff of August 31, 2017, and a deadline for dispositive motions to be heard of
 25 November 2, 2017. ECF No. 15.

26 Good cause exists for a modification of the schedule in this matter. Petitioner is
 27 represented by the UC Davis Civil Rights Clinic (Clinic), an educational program of the
 28 University of California, Davis School of Law. Certified Law Students perform the bulk of the
 work on the Clinic's cases. The law school does not hold classes during the summer, and a new

1 group of law students will begin working on cases on August 21, 2017. The supervising attorney
2 of the Clinic initially believed that only written discovery would be needed in this case. It has
3 recently come to light that several depositions will need to be completed in this case. There is
4 good cause to extend the discovery cutoff in this matter in order to allow Clinic students to
5 participate in defending and possibly taking depositions in this case during the fall 2017
6 semester.

8 Therefore, the parties ask the Court to enter an order modifying the Scheduling Order,
9 extending the deadline for completion of discovery to November 29, 2017, and extending the
10 deadline for dispositive motions to be heard to February 15, 2018.
