By order filed November 30, 2017, petitioner was given thirty 18 19 days to either submit an application to proceed in forma pauperis or pay the filing fee. ECF No. 20 6. Thirty days have now passed and petitioner has not moved to proceed in forma pauperis or 21 paid the filing fee. However, petitioner has submitted a letter to the Clerk of the Court asking 22 whether his filing fee has been received. ECF No. 7. Since the court has not yet received the 23 filing fee, it appears that the payment request may still be processing.
