17	Plaintiff is a state prisoner proceeding pro se and seeking relief pursuant to 42 U.S.C. §		
18	1983. This proceeding was referred to this court by Local Rule 302 pursuant to 28 U.S.C. §		
19	636(b)(1).		
20	Before the court for screening is plaintiff's first amended complaint. The amended		
21	complaint states a cognizable claim under 42 U.S.C. § 1983 and 28 U.S.C. § 1915A(b). If the		
22	allegations of the amended complaint are proven, plaintiff has a reasonable opportunity to prevail		
23	on the merits of his Eighth Amendment claims against defendant Doctors Bick and Dhillon		
24	concerning treatment for "Valley Fever."		
25	As for the remainder of plaintiff's claims, plaintiff either fails to state a claim upon which		
26	relief can be granted, ¹ or has improperly joine	ed claims against other defendants. ²	
27	¹ Defendant asserts defendants Ditomas, Clark and Lewis denied prisoner grievances concerning		
28	the treatment of Bick and Dhillon. But plaint	tiff fails to point to facts indicating that anyone 1

1	In accordance with the above, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:		
2	1. Service is appropriate for defendants Bick and Dhillon.		
3	2. The Clerk of the Court shall send plaintiff two USM-285 forms, one summons, an		
4	instruction sheet and a copy of the amended complaint.		
5	3. Within thirty days from the date of this order, plaintiff shall complete the attached		
6	Notice of Submission of Documents and submit the following documents to the court:		
7	a. The completed Notice of Submission of Documents;		
8	b. One completed summons;		
9	c. One completed USM-285 form for each defendant listed in number 1 above;		
10	and		
11	d. Three copies of the endorsed amended complaint.		
12	4. Plaintiff need not attempt service on defendants and need not request waiver of service.		
13	Upon receipt of the above-described documents, the court will direct the United States Marshal to		
14	serve the above-named defendants pursuant to Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 4 without payment		
15	of costs.		
16	IT IS HEREBY RECOMMENDED that that all defendants other than Bick and Dhillon		
17	be dismissed.		
18	These findings and recommendations are submitted to the United States District Judge		
19	assigned to the case, pursuant to the provisions of 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(l). Within fourteen days		
20	after being served with these findings and recommendations, any party may file written		
21	objections with the court and serve a copy on all parties. Such a document should be captioned		
22			
23	reviewing plaintiff's grievances had the authority to change the treatment prescribed by Dr. Bick or Dr. Dhillon. Plaintiff also fails to allege sufficient facts suggesting he suffered actionable		
24	injury as a result of, at least, the deliberate indifference of the defendants reviewing grievances. See Estelle v. Gamble, 429 U.S. 97, 104-05 (1976).		
25	2 As a general rule, plaintiff may include as many claims as he likes with respect to one		
26	defendant in one action. However, claims against additional defendants in the same action must arise out of the "same transaction, occurrence or series of transactions or occurrences." Fed. R. Civ. P. 20(a)(2)(A). Plaintiff was informed of this when the court dismissed his original complaint with leave to amend.
