BICK, 15 Defendants. 16 17 On June 7, 2018, defendants Bick and Dhillon filed notice with the court, pursuant to 18 Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 25(a), that plaintiff is deceased. Under that rule, a motion to 19 substitute a party for a deceased party must be filed within 90 days of service of the notice of 20 death. No motion for substitution has been made. That being the case, Rule 25 requires that this 21 action be dismissed. 22 IT IS HEREBY RECOMMENDED that this action be dismissed. These findings and recommendations are submitted to the United States District Judge 23 24 assigned to the case, pursuant to the provisions of 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1). Within fourteen days after being served with these findings and recommendations, any party may file written 25 26 objections with the court and serve a copy on all parties. Such a document should be captioned "Objections to Magistrate Judge's Findings and Recommendations." Any response to the 27

objections shall be served and filed within fourteen days after service of the objections. The

28
