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1 Plaintiffs, Bill Barker, Tab Bachman, and William Yingling (“Plaintiffs”) and
2 Defendant, Swift Transportation Company of Arizona, LLC (“Swift”) pursuant to
3 USDC EDCA Local Rule 143 stipulate and agree as follows:

4 1. The parties have agreed to participate in a second mediation which has
5 been scheduled for April 24, 2018 with Judge (ret.) Charles McCoy who previously
6 mediated the case.

7 2. The parties have agreed to stay all proceedings in this matter pending
8 the resolution of the April 24th mediation. If the mediation does not result in a
9 settlement of all of the outstanding issues in the case, the parties agree that the
10 agreed stay shall be lifted and the case will proceed to final resolution.

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
