Plaintiff, a prisoner proceeding pro se, brings this civil rights action pursuant to 42 U.S.C. § 1983. On January 19, 2021, defendants Chambers and Kaur filed a request for an additional ten days in which to respond to the December 18, 2020 order (ECF No. 120). 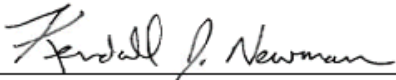
Accordingly, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:
