FINDINGS & RECOMMENDATIONS

By order filed October 13, 2016, plaintiff’s complaint was dismissed and thirty days leave to file an amended complaint was granted. On November 28, 2016, and February 21, 2017, plaintiff was granted extensions of time in which to file an amended complaint. Sixty days from the February 21, 2017 order have now expired, and plaintiff has not filed an amended complaint or otherwise responded to the court’s order.

Accordingly, IT IS HEREBY RECOMMENDED that this action be dismissed without prejudice. See Local Rule 110; Fed. R. Civ. P. 41(b).

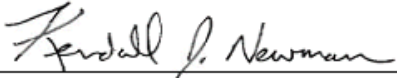
