
ORDER TO SHOW CAUSE

Plaintiff consented to proceed before the undersigned for all purposes. See 28 U.S.C. § 636(c). By an order filed October 11, 2016, this court ordered plaintiff to complete and return to the court, within thirty days, the USM-285 forms necessary to effect service on defendants.
