

ORDER TO SHOW CAUSE

On June 5, 2017, the parties filed a proposed stipulated extension of time. (ECF No. 14.)
On June 6, 2017, the parties' stipulation was granted and plaintiff's motion for summary
judgment and/or remand was ordered to be filed by July 2, 2017. (ECF No. 15.) The July 2,
