1 Plaintiffs Jesse Vang et al. and defendant California Department of Forestry and Fire 2 Protection ("CAL FIRE") have previously stipulated to extend the time for CAL FIRE to respond 3 to the complaint to December 8, 2016, and Court has in an order dated December 2, 2016 (and 4 pursuant to the parties' stipulation) extended that time to January 7, 2017. The parties are 5 awaiting the Court's ruling on the motion to dismiss and the motion to strike filed by defendants 6 Sheriff Jon Lopey, Colleen Setzer, and County of Siskiyou (collectively, "Siskiyou County 7 Defendants"); those motions were set for hearing on November 15, 2016. If Plaintiffs file an amended 15 complaint, the time to respond shall be set by rule or by the Court, and may be extended by 16 stipulation or by the Court.
