ORDER 14 SANG NGO, et al., 15 Defendants. 16 17 Plaintiff commenced this disability access case asserting a claim under the Americans with Disabilities Act ("ADA") and related state law claims, and defendant has answered the 18 19 complaint. 20 In the interest of avoiding the accumulation of fees and costs through potentially 21 unnecessary discovery and motion practice, and to allow the parties some time to pursue an early 22 informal resolution of this matter, the court finds it appropriate to temporarily stay and refer the action to the court's Voluntary Dispute Resolution Program ("VDRP"). 23 24 Accordingly, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that: 1. This action is STAYED and REFERRED to the VDRP. 25 26 2. Within fourteen (14) days of this order, the parties shall contact the court's VDRP 27 administrator, Sujean Park, at (916) 930-4278 or SPark@caed.uscourts.gov, to start 28 the process of selecting an appropriate neutral. 1
