18	On July 12, 2017, defendant filed a motion to dismiss plaintiff's complaint pursuant to	
19	Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 12(b)(6). ECF No. 14. Thereafter, plaintiff was ordered to file	
20	an opposition or statement of non-opposition to defendant's motion by August 11, 2017. ECF	
21	No. 16. To date, plaintiff has not complied with the court's order.	
22	Local Rule 110 provides that failure to comply with court orders "may be grounds for	
23	imposition by the Court of any and all sanctions authorized by statute or Rule or within the	
24	inherent power of the Court." See also Edwards v. Marin Park, Inc., 356 F.3d 1058, 1065 (9th	
25	Cir. 2004) (failure to comply with court orders may be grounds for dismissal pursuant to Federal	
26	Rule of Civil Procedure 41(b)). Pro se litigants are bound by the rules of procedure, even though	
27	pleadings are liberally construed in their favor. King v. Atiyeh, 814 F.2d 565, 567 (9th Cir. 1987).

1	Accordingly, it is hereby ORDERED that:	
2	1. Plaintiff shall show cause, in writing, no later than February 2, 2018, why sanctions	
3	should not be imposed for failure to timely file an opposition or a statement of non-opposition to	
4	the pending motion.	
5	2. Plaintiff shall file an opposition to the motion, or a statement of non-opposition thereto,	
6	no later than February 2, 2018.	
7	3. Failure to file an opposition to the motion will be deemed a statement of non-	
8	opposition thereto, and may result in a recommendation that this action be dismissed for lack of	
9	prosecution and/or for failure to comply with court orders. See Fed. R. Civ. P. 41(b).	
10	4. Defendant may file a reply to plaintiff's opposition, if any, on or before February 16,	
11	2018.
