In response to the motion 20 to dismiss, petitioner requested that, if the court found her petition timely but her ineffective 21 assistance of counsel claim unexhausted, she be granted a stay under Rhines v. Weber, 544 U.S. 22 269 (2005). ECF No. 12 at 5-7.
