19	security action pro se following the withdrawal of her counsel. ECF Nos. 2, 24. On July 27,	
20	2017, the court gave plaintiff 60 days to file a motion for summary judgment. ECF No. 24. The	
21	court warned plaintiff that failure to comply may result in sanctions, including potential dismissal	
22	of this action or entry of default. ECF No. 24. Plaintiff did not file her motion.	
23	Local Rule 110 provides that failure to comply with court orders or the Local Rules "may	
24	be grounds for imposition of any and all sanctions authorized by statute or Rule or within the	
25	inherent power of the Court." In light of plaintiff's new pro se status, the court will grant her an	
26	additional 14 days to file her motion for summary judgment. Failure to file a motion will result in	
27	dismissal of this case for failure to prosecute.	
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1	Accordingly, IT	IS HEREBY ORDERED that:
2	2 1. Plaintiff is Order	red to Show Cause, in writing no later than October 25, 2017, why this
3	action should no	t be dismissed for failure to prosecute;
4	2. Plaintiff's filing	of a motion for summary judgment will result in discharge of this
5	5 Order to Show C	Cause; and
6	3. If plaintiff fails t	o comply with this order, her case will be dismissed.
