ORDER

Plaintiff is a state prisoner, proceeding through counsel, with a civil rights action pursuant to 42 U.S.C. § 1983. On December 5, 2019, defendants filed a motion to stay. (ECF No. 125.) Defendants noticed the motion to stay for hearing before the undersigned on January 9, 2020. (Id.) Plaintiff has not filed an opposition or otherwise responded to defendants' motion to stay.

Accordingly, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:

1. Within seven days of the date of this order, plaintiff shall show cause why sanctions should not be imposed for his failure to respond defendants' motion to stay, and plaintiff shall file an opposition or statement of non-opposition to the motion; and
2. The hearing set for January 9, 2020, before the undersigned regarding defendants' motion to stay is vacated.
