Neither party has filed objections to the findings and recommendations. 23 24 The court has reviewed the file and finds the findings and recommendations to be supported by the record and by the magistrate judge's analysis. Accordingly, IT IS HEREBY 25 26 ORDERED that: 27 1. The findings and recommendations filed January 23, 2020, are adopted in full; 28 2. Defendants' motion to stay (ECF No. 125) is granted; and
