17	28 U.S.C. § 2254. This proceeding was referred to this court by Local Rule 302 pursuant to	28	
18	U.S.C. § 636(b)(1) and is before the undersigned pursuant to petitioner's consent. See 28 U	.S.C.	
19	§ 636; see also E.D. Cal. Local Rules, Appx. A, at (k)(4).		
20	On April 19, 2017, the court reviewed the petition pursuant to Rule 4 of the Rules		
21	Governing Section 2254 Cases. The court found that petitioner had failed to assert that he is	s in	
22	custody in violation of federal law. ECF No. 8. Accordingly, the court granted petitioner th	nirty	
23	days to file an amended petition and warned him that failure to comply would result in this a	action	
24	being dismissed. The time for acting has passed and petitioner has not filed an amended pet	ition,	
25	or otherwise responded to the court's order.		
26	A party's failure to comply with any order or with the Local Rules "may be grounds	for	
27	imposition by the Court of any and all sanctions authorized by statute or Rule or within the		
28	inherent power of the Court." E.D. Cal. Local Rule 110. The court may dismiss an action v	vith or	
	1		

1	without prejudice, as appropriate, if a party disobeys an order or the Local Rules. See Ferdik v.
2	Bonzelet, 963 F.2d 1258, 1263 (9th Cir. 1992) (district court did not abuse discretion in
3	dismissing pro se plaintiff's complaint for failing to obey an order to re-file an amended
4	complaint to comply with Federal Rules of Civil Procedure); Carey v. King, 856 F.2d 1439,
5	1440-41 (9th Cir. 1988) (dismissal for pro se plaintiff's failure to comply with local rule
6	regarding notice of change of address affirmed).
7	Accordingly, it is hereby ORDERED that this action is DISMISSED and the court
8	declines to issue a certificate of appealability.
