18	On May 12, 2017, plaintiff, who proceeds without counsel, filed a stipulated request to	
19	allow plaintiff to utilize the court's electronic filing system. (ECF No. 30.) Local Rule 133	
20	provides that "[a]ny person appearing pro se may not utilize electronic filing except with the	
21	permission of the assigned Judge or Magistrate JudgeAll pro se parties shall file and serve	
22	paper documents as required by applicable Federal Rules of Civil or Criminal Procedure or by	
23	these Rules." E.D. Cal. L.R. 133(b)(2). Here, plaintiff's stipulated request does not set forth a	
24	compelling reason why the court should deviate from the Local Rules and its standard practice of	
25	disallowing the use of electronic filing by pro se litigants.	
26	Therefore, the stipulated request (ECF No. 30) is DENIED.
