17	Plaintiff, a state prisoner proceeding pro se, has filed this civil rights action seeking relief	
18	under 42 U.S.C. § 1983. The matter was referred to a United States Magistrate Judge pursuant to	
19	28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1)(B) and Local Rule 302.	
20	On May 18, 2017, the magistrate judge filed findings and recommendations herein which	
21	were served on plaintiff and which contained notice to plaintiff that any objections to the findings	
22	and recommendations were to be filed within fourteen days. Plaintiff has filed objections to the	
23	findings and recommendations.	
24	In accordance with the provisions of 28 U.S.C. § 636(b)(1)(C) and Local Rule 304, this	
25	court has conducted a <u>de novo</u> review of this case. Having carefully reviewed the entire file, the	
26	court finds the findings and recommendations to be supported by the record and by proper	
27	analysis.

1	The court notes that in his objections, plaintiff again complains of his lack of access to the	
2	law library. Plaintiff requests library access for two hours a day, five days a week. While the	
3	court will not intervene to provide plaintiff this level of access, the court recognizes that plaintiff	
4	may require some library access to respond to the magistrate judge's order giving plaintiff thirty	
5	days to file an amended complaint. If plaintiff is being denied sufficient library access, he may	
6	file a short, plain motion describing what library access, if any, he is currently receiving and	
7	explaining briefly why that access is not sufficient to meet the current deadline in this case.	
8	Accordingly, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:	
9	1. The findings and recommendations filed May 18, 2017, are adopted in full; and	
10	2. Plaintiff's motions for injunctive relief (ECF Nos. 6, 7, 9, 10, and 11) are denied.
