15 Having reviewed the foregoing Stipulation, and good cause appearing  
16 therefore:

17 The Court authorizes the filing of the Third Amended Complaint, a copy of  
18 which is attached hereto as Exhibit A and that will become Plaintiffs’ operative  
19 complaint in this action upon its filing.

20 The Court orders that Defendants’ responsive pleading shall be due thirty (30)  
21 days after the Third Amended Complaint is filed.

22 The Court extends the remaining dates and deadlines as set forth above.
