


1 motions and matters.” L.R. 302(c)(21). The order filed January 6, 2017 was not a dispositive
2 order in that plaintiff was granted leave to amend.

3 Because it appears that plaintiff may have been under a misapprehension regarding the
4 need to file an amended complaint in compliance with the court’s January 6, 2017 order, the court
5 will grant an extension of time to file an amended complaint. Plaintiff is cautioned that the filing
6 of a motion for reconsideration does not automatically stay the effect of a non-dispositive order
7 issued by the Magistrate Judge.

8 In accordance with the above, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that no later than March 10,
9 2017 plaintiff shall file an amended complaint that complies with the January 6, 2017 order.
10 Failure to timely file an amended complaint will result in a recommendation that the action be
11 dismissed.
