18	Plaintiff is proceeding in this action pro se and in forma pauperis. By order filed January		
19	6, 2017, plaintiff's complaint was dismissed and thirty days leave to file an amended complaint		
20	was granted. The thirty day period has now expired, and plaintiff has not filed an amended		
21	complaint.		
22	On February 7, 2017, plaintiff filed a motion for reconsideration by the District Judge of		
23	the January 6, 2017 order. ¹ Plaintiff is advised that Local Rule 302(c)(21) provides in relevant		
24	part that the duties to be performed in civil matters by a Magistrate Judge pursuant to 28 U.S.C. §		
25	636(a), (b)(1)(A), (b)(1)(B), (b)(3) include "[i]n Sacramento, all actions in which all the plaintiffs		
26	or defendants are proceeding in propria persona, including dispositive and non-dispositive

1	motions and matters." L.R. 302(c)(21). The order filed January 6, 2017 was not a dispositive		
2	order in that plaintiff was granted leave to amend.		
3	Because it appears that plaintiff may have been under a misapprehension regarding the		
4	need to file an amended complaint in compliance with the court's January 6, 2017 order, the court		
5	will grant an extension of time to file an amended complaint. Plaintiff is cautioned that the filing		
6	of a motion for reconsideration does not automatically stay the effect of a non-dispositive order		
7	issued by the Magistrate Judge.		
8	In accordance with the above, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that no later than March 10,		
9	2017 plaintiff shall file an amended complaint that complies with the January 6, 2017 order.		
10	Failure to timely file an amended complaint will result in a recommendation that the action be		
11	dismissed.
