



1 IT IS HEREBY STIPULATED, that the parties will have until after the hearing on  
2 Defendants' Motions to Dismiss, calendared for May 4, 2017 to meet and confer pursuant to  
3 Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 26(f) and submit a written report. Pursuant to the Court's  
4 Initial Pretrial Scheduling Order, the parties met and conferred on March 27, 2017. During that  
5 meeting, the parties discussed several issues including an appropriate protective order, notice  
6 correspondence pursuant to Federal Educational Rights and Privacy Act (FERPA), and a date  
7 for Initial Disclosures. Subsequently, considering the amount of parties and that several parties  
8 only recently appeared in the case, the parties agree that waiting to hold a Rule 26(f) conference  
9 until within fourteen (14) days after the passing of the May 4, 2017 hearing date, to May 18,  
10 2017, would be prudent.
