1 pay the filing fee. No further extensions of time will be granted. 2 Finally, on the form providing plaintiff's consent to the jurisdiction of the undersigned 3 magistrate judge, plaintiff requests appointment of counsel. See ECF No. 4. This is an 4 inappropriate method for requesting appointment of counsel. Should this action proceed, and 5 should plaintiff seek appointment of counsel, he must file a separate request. See Palmer v. 6 Valdez, 560 F.3d 965, 970 (9th Cir. 2009) (appointment of counsel may be made only in 7 exceptional circumstances that include an evaluation of the plaintiff's ability to articulate his 8 claims pro se and his likelihood of success). 9 Accordingly, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that: 10 1. Plaintiff shall, within 21 days after the filing date of this order, submit: (1) an affidavit 11 in support of his request to proceed in forma pauperis on the form provided herewith by the Clerk 12 of Court, OR (2) the required fees in the amount of \$400.00. 13 2. Failure to timely comply with this order will result in the dismissal of this action 14 without prejudice. 15 3. Plaintiff's request for appointment of counsel, ECF No. 4, is denied without prejudice. 16 4.
