The U.S. Postal Inspection Service has sent the written notice of intent to forfeit required 23 by 18 U.S.C. § 983(a)(1)(A) to all known interested parties. The time has expired for any person to file a 24 claim to the defendant currency under 18 U.S.C. § 983(a)(2)(A)-(E), and no person other than claimant 25 has filed a claim to the defendant currency as required by law in the administrative forfeiture proceeding. 26

Under 18 U.S.C. § 983(a)(3)(A), the United States is required to file a complaint for

currency is subject to forfeiture within ninety days after a claim has been filed in the administrative 1 forfeiture proceeding, unless the court extends the deadline for good cause shown or by agreement of the 2 parties. That deadline is January 26, 2016. 3 4. As provided in 18 U.S.C. § 983(a)(3)(A), the parties wish by agreement to extend to April 4 25, 2016, the time in which the United States is required to file a civil complaint for forfeiture against the 5 defendant currency and/or to obtain an indictment alleging that the defendant currency is subject to 6 forfeiture. 7 5.
