ORDER

17 Plaintiff, a state prisoner proceeding pro se, has filed a civil rights action pursuant to 42
18 U.S.C. § 1983. Plaintiff has not, however, filed a properly completed in forma pauperis affidavit
19 or paid the required filing fee of \$350.00 plus the \$50.00 administrative fee.¹ See 28 U.S.C.
20 §§ 1914(a), 1915(a). Therefore, plaintiff will be provided the opportunity either to submit a
21 properly completed affidavit in support of a request to proceed in forma pauperis or to submit the
22 required fees totaling \$400.00.

23 Plaintiff is cautioned that the in forma pauperis application form includes a section that
24 must be completed by a prison official, and the form must be accompanied by a certified copy of
25 ///

27 ¹ If leave to file in forma pauperis is granted, plaintiff will still be required to pay the filing fee
28 but will be allowed to pay it in installments. Litigants proceeding in forma pauperis are not
required to pay the \$50.00 administrative fee.


1 plaintiff's prison trust account statement for the six-month period immediately preceding the
2 filing of this action.

3 In accordance with the above, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that:

4 1. Plaintiff shall submit, within thirty days from the date of this order, a properly
5 completed affidavit in support of his request to proceed in forma pauperis on the form provided
6 by the Clerk of Court, or the required fees in the amount of \$400.00; plaintiff's failure to comply
7 with this order will result in a recommendation that this action be dismissed; and

8 2. The Clerk of the Court is directed to send plaintiff a new Application to Proceed In
9 Forma Pauperis By a Prisoner.
