The court has reviewed the file and finds the findings and recommendations to be 18 19 supported by the record and by the magistrate judge's analysis. Accordingly, IT IS HEREBY 20 ORDERED that: 21 1. The findings and recommendations filed May 14, 2018, are adopted in full; and 22 2.
